Welcome to Robins class. Please find below an overview of our topics and subjects for the Spring Term 1 2019. In addition to this, we will be doing daily Maths and Literacy lessons.

As **Geographers** we will be learning about the location of different Polar Regions and the oceans. Children will compare different regions and discuss possible similarities and differences. The children will also explore the lives of in the Inuit people and the effects of global warming on the plant

As **Historians** we will be learning about the expeditions of Scott and Shackleton as part of the historical life of Britain. The children will compare different Victorian inventions and how they compare to modern day polar equipment.

As **Scientists** we will be identifying different polar animals and studying their habitats, camouflage and food chains. The children will investigate the properties of materials by exploring changing states of water.

As those who are **Physically Active** we will be practising gymnastics on the apparatus thinking about the different ways we can use and control our bodies to perform specific movements and balances. The children will learn to play Tag Rugby, practising the skills of catching, passing, evasion and playing within the rules.

As **Artists** we will be learning about using cold colours to paint and collage different polar scenes. The children will also practise shaping clay using tools and manipulation.

As those who study **spirituality and religions** of the world, we will be learning about Judaism and considering their practices and beliefs.
